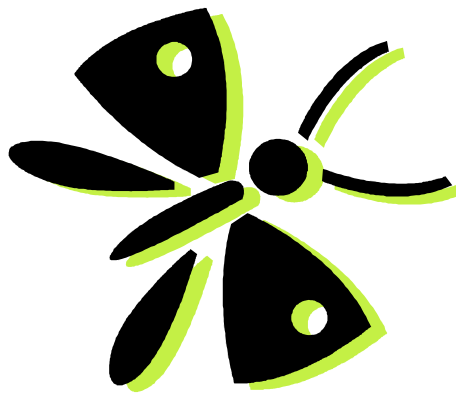

Butterfly Handprints

What you need:

A piece of paper
Paint
Paint tray
Cardboard roll
Pen
Goggle Eyes
Glue
Your hands!
Apron



What you need to do?

1. First you need to put on an apron.
2. Take a piece of paper, a paint tray, and your favourite colour paint
3. Pour a small amount of paint into the tray and either put one hand in the tray to cover in paint or paint your hand using a brush.
4. Once your hand has been painted, make a handprint onto the paper. Wash the paint off and then paint the other hand. These will be the wings of your butterfly.
5. Once you have two handprints on the paper, take a cardboard tube and roll it in the paint in the tray.
6. Glue the cardboard tube in the middle of the two handprints to make the body of the butterfly.
7. Once the cardboard tube is dry you can then draw or stick on the butterfly's eyes and mouth.
8. Once the butterfly is complete you can then add another colour onto the wings for decoration.
